

## **ARNOLD RICHARD DUPONT**

Lt. Col. Arnold Richard DuPont, (U.S. Army. Ret.) 69, of Jackson, passed away unexpectedly on October 31. Mr. DuPont was born in Gardner, Mass. and grew up in Attica, N.Y. Mr. DuPont graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy, class of 1960, and went on to take a commission in the U.S. Army. He spent 23 years in the Army, retiring as a lieutenant colonel. He received his masters degrees from Ohio State in operational research and Loyola University of Chicago in pastoral studies. After retiring from the Army, he was employed at Bell Labs, Holmdel. He was a pioneer in telecommunications, fiber optics and operational research.
